

Introduction

After last year's very successful activities week, this year's week will take place between Monday 14th July and Friday 18th July.

Students in Year 7 will take part in a range of educational and extracurricular opportunities that go beyond the regular curriculum. These activities, including trips, workshops, and specialized lessons, are designed to build on students' learning in the classroom as well as introduce them to new skills and experiences.

Students will largely be based in their tutor groups during the week. There will be three offsite days, at Newquay Zoo, Camel Creek and Trevassack Lake. For the two onsite days, students will be able to choose from a range of activities including:

- Physical Activity Day
- A Super Science Challenge Day
- Music Day
- Engineering Challenge Day
- Fun Upcycled Fashion T-shirt making
- Ultimate Movie Marathon
- Lucky Dip

The cost

The cost of the whole week, including transport and entrance to the activities is £85. We understand that you may have questions regarding the £85 charge for Activities Week during curriculum time. The cost covers transportation, materials, and expert instructors. We are committed to providing the best possible education, and your support through this fee helps us continue offering these valuable opportunities to enhance your child's education. Parents can pay the cost all at once or spread the cost across the year through 5 instalments of £17. Parents / carers can cover the cost through Parent Pay.

Selecting activities

Please can all parents/ carers fill out an online form from Monday 2nd December, to select which two school based activities your child would like to participate in. The activities based at Helston Community College may have a maximum group size. Places will be allocated on first come first served basis when the form is filled in. Please only fill out the form once per student. Any duplicate entries, we will take the answers from the first entry. Once we have received all students' selections, we will then update Parentpay. We appreciate, there may be instances where you child would like to change their activity options. This can be done via an email to school, up until the Christmas break. After this time, we will no longer accept any activity changes, unless a students has been absent due to illness or another genuine reason. All parents should have access to a Parent Pay account already, however, some may need to activate their account by using the details in the email from Parent Pay which was sent at the start of September. Consent forms

In order for your child to take part in the week we will need two forms of consent:

1. Your consent for your child to take part in the specific trip. This will be via Parent Pay, where you will be required to tick a box.

2. We also need to collect a more detailed consent for your child to take part in trips generally. The College sent a link to a new annual general consent form for 2024-25 in September and if this has not yet been completed, it must be before the trip goes as it contains all the contact details and medication information the College needs to ensure the trip runs safely.
