### **BIG PICTURE**

In Year 12 and 13 the PSHE Curriculum is predominantly delivered by tutors, within tutor time. Within each year group, all three elements of the PSHE curriculum will be studied: health and wellbeing, RSE and living in the wider world. This is supplemented by extended assemblies and drop down lessons to attend workshops ran by external agencies. The curriculum aims to focus on current issues students face and helping them to make informed independent decisions. As well as providing signposting and providing guidance to help and inform students. Some elements of living in the wider world will be covered under the careers programme which is set out separately.
