



CORONAVIRUS (COVID 19) FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What to do if...	Action Needed	Your child cannot return to school until
...your child has coronavirus symptom(s).	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Your child must not come to College. • You must advise the College of the symptom(s) of your child. • Your child (and your household) must self-isolate. • Your child must have a test within 24 hours. • You must advise the College of the results. • You must update the College every 3 days thereafter 	<p><i>after</i> your child has received a negative test result <u>and</u> you have advised the College of the result, Or <i>after</i> your child has self-isolated for 10 days from when your child's symptoms started.</p> <p>(Your child must not return to College before the 10 days have elapsed unless a negative test result has been received).</p>
...your child tests positive for coronavirus.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Your child must not come to College. • You must advise the College of the test outcome as soon as possible. • Self-isolate for a further 10 days from test result 	<p><i>after</i> 10 days (if s/he feels well enough) even if s/he still has a cough or loss of smell/taste. These symptoms can last even when the virus has gone and the person is no longer infectious.</p>
...somebody in your household has coronavirus symptom(s).	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Your child must not come to College. • Your child (and your household) must self-isolate. • The household member must have a test within 24 hours • You must advise the College of the results. 	<p><i>after</i> the household member has received a negative test result <u>and</u> you have advised the College of the result,</p> <p>Or <i>after</i> your child has self-isolated for 10 days from when your household member's symptoms started, unless your child becomes symptomatic – then please follow the guidance as above.</p>
...somebody in your household has tested positive for coronavirus.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Your child must not come to College. • Your child (and your household) must self-isolate for 10 days. 	<p><i>after</i> your child has self-isolated for 10 days from when your household member's symptoms started, unless your child becomes symptomatic – then please follow the guidance as above.</p>
...NHS have identified your child as a 'close contact' of somebody with symptoms/confirmed coronavirus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Your child must not come to College. • Your child must self-isolate for 10 days. 	<p><i>after</i> your child has self-isolated for 10 days, unless your child becomes symptomatic – then please follow the guidance as above</p>
...you have received medical advice that your child must resume shielding	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Your child must not come to College. • You must provide evidence to College pertaining to the shielding. • Once shielding restrictions are lifted/paused, you must inform pastoral staff of the day your child will return to school 	<p><i>after</i> the shielding restriction has been lifted/paused.</p>

Please note: When a family member tests positive, the whole household must self-isolate for 10 days
 When a family member has symptoms the whole household must isolate until a negative test result is received or for 10 days, providing they do not become symptomatic.
 Absence from school under these circumstances will not count against your child.
