Learn to Live Programme – Regal Cinema, Redruth - Tuesday 26th September 2017

The College feels a proactive approach should be adopted towards young driver education in an effort to reduce the risks facing young drivers in Cornwall. We have therefore decided to invite all Year 12 students to attend a road safety programme called Learn to Live. This programme is designed to develop awareness of safe driving techniques and to discuss the consequences associated with dangerous driving.

The Learn to Live Programme is a very hard hitting, emotive programme with representatives from Police, Ambulance, Fire, A&E Consultant, a crash victim, and an offender. Each representative walks onto a darkened stage and gives a testimonial on what happens and how serious road traffic collisions can be. Support is provided at the event for students who find this topic distressing.

This year the Learn to Live Programme is being hosted at the Regal Cinema, Redruth on Tuesday 26th September. The students should meet in the College bus park at 12.15pm and they will return no later than 3.15pm. Please indicate your agreement to your son/daughter attending this event by signing and returning the enclosed Parental Consent Form by Friday 22nd September 2017.

We feel it is imperative for all Year 12 students to participate in the Learn to Live programme and we will be collapsing the timetable so all students can attend. Attendance at this event could save one or many lives and in many ways this is the most important trip we take all year.
