Nationality and Country of Birth

Schools are now required to provide the Government with the Nationality and Country of Birth of all our students.

Pupil nationality is collected for all students, and relates to the nationality of the student as stated by the parent/guardian and/or child (in the case of a child without a parent/guardian). The country of birth would be expected to appear on – or be derived from – the child’s birth certificate or passport. Where a child is born in unusual circumstances – i.e. outside of national boundaries (e.g. in international water) - the student may be classified as “stateless”.
