Progression Pathway Day and Parent Information Evening – Tuesday 18th July 2017

On Tuesday 18th July, we are holding a Progression Pathway Day for Year 12 students starting at 9.15am in the Main College Hall. We will all be together period 1 for a workshop on writing a strong personal statement, which is necessary for any progression pathway. The rest of the day, the students will be able to choose between apprenticeship, military and university pathways.

The workshop will be of paramount importance and it is expected that all Level 3 students will attend. Please note that students interested in applying to university should bring their GCSE certificates to allow them to enter their qualifications correctly on their UCAS application. There will also be a team of student ambassadors and former Helston Community College students to support and offer advice.

On the evening of Tuesday 18th July 2017, there will be an information session directed at parents and carers to inform you of the UCAS (university) application process. Gemma Champion, who is the Outreach Officer for Swansea University, will be assisting with the session. The evening will start at 6.30pm and will be located in the Main College Hall. The objective of the session is to explain what is involved in this process, how best to provide support to your son / daughter and give you a chance to ask any questions.

The duration of the evening will last approximately one hour. Please will you indicate your intention to attend the evening session by signing and returning the tear-off slip below to Mrs Jane Rowe in the Post 16 Office by Friday 14th July.
