Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to inform you about an exciting new opportunity for students in KS4 to enrich their study and understanding of English. In conjunction with Falmouth University, the English department has created a programme of workshops and events aimed at supporting all students in their study of English Language and Literature at KS4. The idea is that these workshops will provide an exciting and inspirational addition to the English curriculum. They range from the creative and artistic to the intellectual and analytical. We are hoping that the students who attend them will find them challenging, thought-provoking and fun.

These workshops will replace the previous after school intervention sessions run by the department and will provide a wider variety of experiences to enhance both their skills and enjoyment in the subject. The study of English is not just in the classroom, and it is vital that the students gain a greater understanding of both Language and Literature in a wider context. We are particularly excited about the opportunities offered by Falmouth University where some of their lecturers will be here at the college to deliver workshops specifically tailored for our students.
